Resolve was running a part-time service supporting people with high demand drug and alcohol issues. As a result of the growth in funding, of which the TFN funds was a meaningful part, we have been able to support even larger numbers of people than before.

Were you able to leverage further funding as a result of TFN support?	Yes
If yes, how much were you able to raise?	Total raised from funders including Lloyds Foundation, Paradigm Foundation and the local authority has amounted to over £100,000 over two years

How important was TFN funding in helping you achieve your objectives?	We would have found it difficult to achieve our objectives without TFN funding
Since presenting at TFN, has your organisation undergone any other significant changes?	Resolve has grown significantly, further developed our work at the Hatfield site and is now providing services across three sites in Hertfordshire. One of the very few organisations that have expanded service provision over the last few years.
Do you have any other comments or feedback on the experience of the TFN process?	The TFN experience was a really positive one for Resolve. We had a lot of fun with the whole process and I know that our pitch on the night was well received by our own people - staff and service users who came. I would very much welcome the chance to do this again but wonder if there is a format in which larger funders who might be interested in being more involved with the charity they chose might be possible?
