Were you able to undertake your project as planned?	Yes
Can you describe and/or demonstrate the specific impact that TFN funding has had against your initial objectives?	The funding has had a huge impact and helped Plastic Shed develop and test ideas for it's social impact and business model. Thanks to the funding from the Crowdbacker event we have been able to run 13 free, open to all workshops in Stockport, in partnership with charities, schools, local businesses and community groups including Signpost For Carers, St John's Primary School, Re-Dish (a local charity) and Tandem Coffee House. At these workshops we have been able to co-design ideas for how Plastic Shed can really bring the whole community together and run activities that suit different time commitments and abilities. The funding has paid for tools and equipment and insurance, as well as paying contractors to help run successful workshops. Having these resources for our workshops has meant we've been able to work with over 300 people to turn a huge amount of plastic waste into new things for the community. We've made planters from vinyl banners, clipboards from shredding and melting bottle lids, purses from plastic packaging and decorations for the town's christmas tree.
	We've been able to take photos of these workshops and use them to promote Plastic Shed and build our profile (our website was funded by the TFN money). Our growing profile has meant we've now sold over 5 workshops to festivals, businesses, community groups such as the Women's Insitute and a Stockport based housing association. The funding has also allowed us to run pilots in schools which has meant we've then go on to sell workshops to 3 local schools.

We gained over £2000 in revenue from running the day and we now use this as an example of our offer to other organisations.

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
