To promote organic fair trade in India, to provide food security and a sustainable future for peasant farmers and rural communities, and setting-up an organic canteen for street children in **Delhi.**

As part of the development of the organic canteen in Delhi, catering for 200 street children, a successful Chef's programme has been developed. This involves holding cooking classes during which, following cooking demonstrations, the children learn and cook for each other. The recipes are high in nutrition and are also made tasty (as can be testified by Navdanya staff!), without the need for highly spiced food that street children are used to. A Documentary has been filmed with the provisional title 'Good Food for All' (of which these cooking sessions also form part). Clips can be provided upon request.

Participatory dialogues have been held with peasant farmers every month to elaborate principles of organic fair trade at local, national and global levels, and to establish a detailed framework and action plan for fair trade rules on food and agriculture. These dialogues have been photographed and recorded for future reference. Strategy workshops have also been held with partners in Africa and UK for global action on organic fair trade, and have provided the opportunity for sharing principles, policies, and best practices for organic fair trade.
