Can you describe and/or demonstrate the specific impact that TFN funding has had against your initial objectives?	<p>With the support from TFN we have been able to extend our reach in terms of both participants and geographical area. Over the past 12 months we have expanded our centres into Lincolnshire with sites and partnerships at Humberside Airport, Scunthorpe United and Grimsby Town FC. Offering both 10 week programmes and one off experience days promoting practical learning, maths and English activities and increase in aspirations and confidence.</p> <p>Your support has also helped us to increase the number of children and young people we have been able to reach and this year have increased participants from 1,973 last academic year to 2,987 this academic year. We have also been able to increase our provision with additional days at two of our satellite centres.</p> <p>We have been able to work with 49 different schools and organisations from Hull, East Yorkshire and Lincolnshire.</p> <p>This summer we are able to offer holidays programmes with exciting activities and fun at our main MKM Stadium site.</p> <p>Positive outcomes have also included the recruitment of two new members of staff, an admin co-ordinator and fundraising officer to support the running and continued growth of the charity.</p> <p>When asked how our programmes have supported them, over 84% of learners said that it helped them to grow in confidence and 100% of teachers strongly agree that learners confidence and self esteem have grown since starting on one of our programmes. 98.2% of participants said that putting numeracy and literacy skills into practice in a functional way was invaluable to them.</p>
