<b>Can you describe and/or demonstrate the specific impact that TFN funding has had against your initial objectives?</b>	<p>The funds raised from the TFN Rainmaker event supported 10 girls with a mentor for a school year: helping them to have more confidence in themselves, to access opportunities they might otherwise not have access to, and be ambitious for their futures.</p> <p>All girls grew their network of professional women and reported doing as well as they'd hoped, if not better, on their end of year academic results.</p> <p>Across the country, 95% of girls increased in their resilience and 89% of girls grew in their key communication skills. 90% of girls demonstrated moderate to very high levels of growth in confidence. 75% increased in their self-reports of motivation, and 75% grew in their self-belief.</p> <p>Teacher, London: 'The girls were really overcome with who they talked to, the networking they were able to do and the work experience / work shadowing opportunities they have set up for themselves. Because of who they met, the things they were able to discuss and the opportunities they've created, the girls described it as one of life's events that they will never forget. I had goose bumps talking to them!'</p>
