Can you describe and/or demonstrate the specific impact that TFN funding has had against your initial objectives?	The TFN funding invested in Universify staff time to convert existing relationships with partner university colleges into cofunding partnerships. Prior to TFN funding partner university colleges provided meals and accommodation for Universify's residential programme as a benefit in kind. In aiming to convert these partnerships into funding relationships our vision was to enable Universify to create a new and consistent income stream that would act as a platform from which the charity could sustainably scale to provide our proven, impactful programme to more participants.
	Since receiving TFN funding we have translated four of our six university college partnerships into funding relationships, generating over £40,000 of income for Universify for the coming year and part-funding 160 places on the Universify programme. From this foundation we have also secured addition funding from trusts and foundations, including with grantmakers where our
	applications have previously been unsuccessful. This new income stream means that as a charity we can more confidently plan programme growth to reach more participants who are most at risk of not fulfilling their potential in education.
